As part of our response to the ongoing situation, we wanted to provide an opportunity for families to participate together in worship and growing in their walk with Jesus. As Pastor Jon has pointed out “You can’t cancel church. We ARE the church!”

With that in mind, we are sending a little bit of Kingdom Kids home to you. Below is a link to some of our Kingdom Kids program for today. Everything you need, to disciple your kids (and yourselves) through the selected passages is included in a single page! I would encourage you to read each story out loud together, and then simply work your way through the sheet. (One lesson also has an accompanying video for you to watch)

The first lesson teaches us about Jesus, and the Samaritan Woman at the well. The passage is: John 4:5-42. Jesus takes his disciples somewhere they didn’t expect to go, and shows them how to love someone they wouldn’t normally even speak to.

In the second lesson, we learn about Mary and Martha. The passage is Luke 10:38-42. Sometimes we get our priorities wrong. Sometimes we might think we need to impress Jesus or others. Jesus teaches these two women what matters most.
