### **Monday – Your ‘One Thing’**

*What is the ‘one thing’ on your heart these days? Maybe you’re already praying about it or maybe you’ve stopped. Why don’t take some time to write out a simple prayer to God and then invite someone to join you in praying about your ‘one thing’ moving forward.*

### **Tuesday – Salvation**

*Let’s pray for our unsaved friends and family. Ask that God would overwhelm them with his loving presence and don’t forget to ask God to use you! Why don’t you reach out to that person this week?*

### **Wednesday – the Persecuted Church**

*It is hard to imagine what many Christians experience around the world. Let’s kneel in solidarity with our persecuted brothers and sisters as we pray for their safety and courage for, the strengthening and growth of churches being persecuted and pray that their persecutors would find Christ. Let’s also pray for missionaries serving around the world, including Canada!*

### **Thursday – Trulls Road Church (and friends)**

*Pray for our church family and ministries. Ask God to use us to impact each other and our community with the gospel. Feel free to come visit the building to pray. Let's also remember the other churches in our community, our ministry partners, and the Free Methodist Ministry Centre,*
